

2009 TOOBORAC RABBIT RAMBLE COOK-OFF ENTRY FORM

So you think your rabbit dish is the best? Well, here's your chance to prove it.

This community event is held at the Tooborac Hall and it is where you get to show off your culinary prowess. Judged by a panel of rabbit connoisseurs, entries are scored on presentation, taste, texture and imagination (the X factor) with the winner receiving \$100 and an engraved chef's knife. At the conclusion of the judging, everyone sits down to share their entry with friends and fellow contestants over lunch (contestants are required to cook enough for six people).

Judging starts at 11am and general entry is from 12.30pm, the winner will be announced during lunch. Entries must be made from wild rabbit (not farmed) and can be ordered through the Tooborac General Store. Entrants should prepare their dishes for six people and bring picnic equipment and any accompaniments they require for themselves, their guests and the presentation of their dishes to the judges. Non-rabbit eaters are also welcome to bring along a substitute meal. Basic kitchen facilities and a warming oven for final preparation of your entry are available.

The cost to enter a dish is \$25 (which admits two people to the cook-off) and non-competing guests are welcome at \$5 per person (payable on the day). Children under 12 years old are admitted free.
