

# 2010 TOOBORAC RABBIT RAMBLE ENTRY FORM

So you think your rabbit dish is the best? Well, here's your chance to prove it at the annual Tooborac Rabbit Cook-off.

This community event is held at the Tooborac Hall (on the Northern Hwy) and it is where you get to show off your culinary prowess. Judged by a panel of rabbit connoisseurs, entries are scored on presentation, taste, texture and imagination (the X factor) with the winner receiving an engraved chef's knife. At the conclusion of the judging, everyone sits down to share their entry with friends and fellow contestants over lunch (contestants are required to cook enough for six people).

Entries must be made from wild rabbit (not farmed) and can be ordered from Shelmerdine Vineyards one week prior to the event. Entrants should bring any garnish, equipment or accompaniments they may require. Basic kitchen facilities including an oven and microwave are available.

Judging starts at 11am. Lunch is from 12.30pm. The cost to enter a dish is \$15 (which admits two people to the cook-off). Children are admitted free. **Please drop your entry form into Cellar and Store, High Street, Heathcote prior to the event.**
