

2011 TOOBORAC RABBIT RAMBLE

ENTRY FORM

Sunday 23 October

Entries must be made from wild rabbit (not farmed). Entrants should bring any pots, pans or equipment they may require to cook/heat up their dish and whatever props, garnish, accompaniments required to finish your dish ready for judging. Basic kitchen facilities include a domestic oven and stove top, a microwave and an electric outside barbecue are available.

There are two categories in which to enter: home cook (general entry) and professional (previous winners and chefs). Dishes are scored out of 40 points: 10/presentation, 10/aroma and taste, 10/texture and 10/X factor.

Apart from the cook-off, there will also be the table setting competition. A suitable prize will be awarded to the person/s with the best rabbit-themed table setting. So polish the silverware, dust off the rabbit-shaped candelabra and starch the napkins ... your effort may not be not in vain. Entry for the table setting competition is available on the day

Non-competing visitors are welcome to attend the cook-off. Visitors are encouraged to enter the table setting competition. Due to the popularity of the event visitors must book in advance and should bring a picnic lunch to compliment the shared rabbit dishes on offer.

Entry forms can be handed in at Cellar and Store, 105 High Street, Heathcote or posted to Tooborac Rabbit Ramble, 2430 Lancefield Rd, Tooborac 3522 (cheques payable to the Tooborac Rabbit Ramble).

Judging starts at 11am. Lunch is from 12.30pm. The cost to enter a dish is \$15 (which admits two people to the cook-off) and non-competing guests are welcome at \$15 per person (payable on the day). Children are admitted free.
